Raising Attainment in Reading Comprehension: 'Inference Training'

A **one day** course to equip practitioners in implementing a group intervention to raise pupil attainment in inferential comprehension, as well as applying key intervention principles/strategies in the classroom context

'Inference Training' is a research-based *group intervention for KS2 and KS3 pupils with a focus on teaching reading comprehension* delivered by teachers or teaching assistants. This intervention programme supports *accelerated pupil progress by an average of 12 months progress* in comprehension over a period of 10 weeks.

This course will address:

- Raising attainment in reading for KS2 & KS3 pupils who have age appropriate decoding skills but who are experiencing difficulty acquiring full meaning and enjoyment from their reading
- Key characteristics of reading comprehension and barriers to learning
- Explicit identification of individual pupil difficulties in comprehending texts
- How to deliver a structured approach to the teaching of Inference Intervention sessions
- Applying key principles of 'Inference Training' Intervention to quality first teaching in the classroom context
- How to evaluate impact on data and effectiveness on pupil attainment and progress
