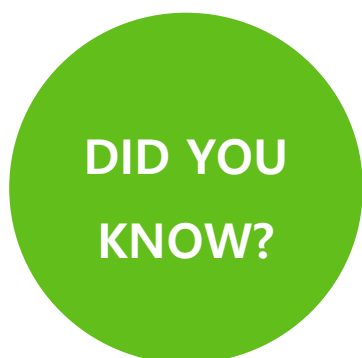

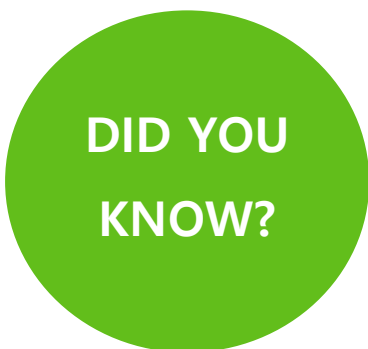

Raising Attainment in Reading Comprehension: 'Inference Training'

A one day course to equip practitioners to implement a group intervention to raise pupil attainment in inferential comprehension, as well as applying the key intervention principles and strategies in the classroom context

'Inference Training' is a research-based *group intervention for KS2 and KS3 pupils with a focus on teaching reading comprehension* delivered by teachers or teaching assistants. This intervention programme supports *accelerated pupil progress by an average of 12 months progress* in comprehension over a period of 10 weeks.

Boosting Reading@Primary (BR@P)

A one day course to equip practitioners to implement a one to one group intervention to raise attainment in reading, as well as developing a skill base to support pupils' general reading development from Y1 to Y6

'Boosting Reading@Primary' is a one-to-one intervention programme targeted at Y1 to Y6 pupils. The intervention lessons are delivered three times per week by teaching assistants for 10 weeks. Each session lasts for 15 minutes and includes:

Write Away Together

A one day course to equip practitioners to implement a one to one group intervention to raise attainment in writing, as well as developing a skill base to support pupils' general writing development from Y2 to Y6

'Write Away Together' is a one-to-one intervention programme targeted at Y2 to Y6 pupils. The intervention lessons are delivered two times per week by teaching assistants for a minimum of 10 weeks. Each session lasts for 20 - 30 minutes and includes:

- Supporting pupils to develop key strategies for evaluating and improving their writing
- A focus on the key areas of grammar to ensure effective composition
- Ongoing assessment

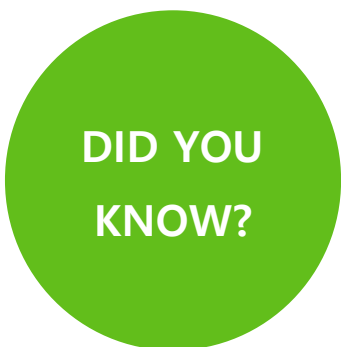
